



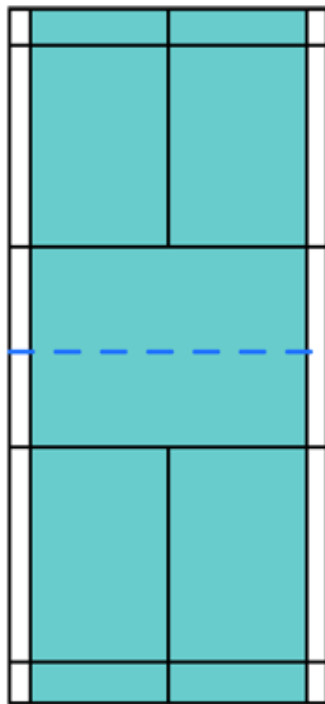

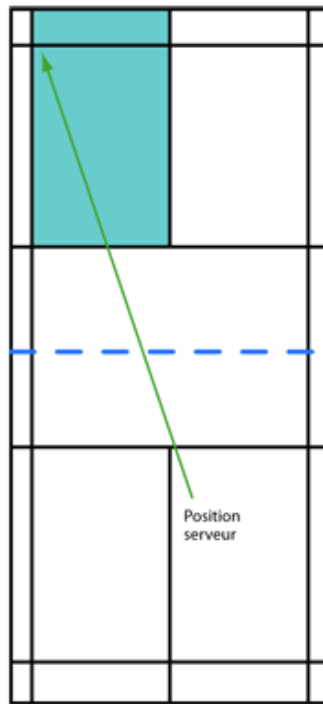
### **Rules of Badminton - Single**

- To score a point the shuttlecock must hit within the defined surface of the opponents court. See figure below for the defined surface area.
- If the shuttlecock hits the net or lands out then a point is awarded to your opponent.
- 21 points are required to win a set. If the score is 20-20, then a difference of two points is required to win the set (eg. 22-20, 23-21, 24-22...). If the score reaches 29-29, the next player to win a point wins the set.
- Players must serve diagonally across the net to their opponent. Your score defines which side you serve on: if you have an odd amount of points (eg. 1,3,5,7...) you serve from left to right; if you have an even amount of points (eg. 0,2,4,6...) you serve from right to left.
- There are no second serves so if your first serve goes out then your opponent wins the point.
- A serve must be hit underarm and below the servers waist. No overarm serves are allowed.
- If a player touches the net with any part of their body or racket then it is deemed a fault and their opponent receives the point.
- The qualification games are decided by 1 winning set.

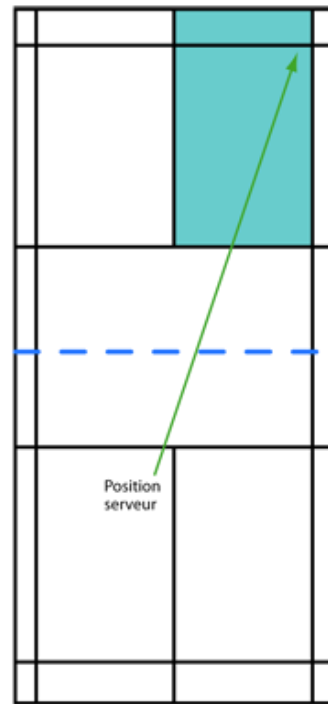
- The knockout games are decided by 2 winning sets.
